Tasting Notes:

The 2018 Commitment Shiraz is deep, dark purple in color exuding aromas of blackberries and cherry cola complimented with hints of eucalyptus, licorice, nutmeg and black pepper. The palate comes alive with tastes of sweet berries and light vanilla complexed with characters of cloves, cinnamon, coffee, fennel and dark chocolate. Velvety, soft tannins tensioned with tight acidity create a long toasty, cherry licorice finish.

Winemaker Notes:

2018 was an great year for Shiraz, good winter rains created ideal conditions to begin the growing season, with just enough rainful in the autumn to allow the fruit to develop post veraison Aged for 24 months in American and French oak hogsheads to reinforce and soften the structure, this wine is still young in the bottle and will continue to develp for 10+ years.
