Tasting Notes:

Lively, bright straw in colour, this wine displays aromas of lychee, pineapple and rockmelon. Subtle hints of toasted cashews, butterscotch and baking spice are present throughout from aging in 30% new French oak along with 9 months on lees to create a rich hazelnut cream base. Complex flavours including lychee, nectarine, and madarin zest paired with a creamy mouthfeel are balanced by an acid backbone that leaves a generous finish.

Winemaker Notes:

The Chardonnay was harvested in the cool of the and gently pressed in our basket press. A cool fermentation followed to retain varietal characteristics. The wine went through partial Malolactic Fermentation in 30% new large format French oak puncheons. The wine was stirred periodically to develop secondary characteristics and mouthfeel.
