Tasting Notes:

Beautifully structured and refined, the 2018 Thoroughbred shows aromas of wild plums and rhubarb with hints of tobacco, fennel and mulberries. Elegant and refined fruit of blackberries and mulberries play on the palate complimented with flavours of roasted hazelnut and leather persisting through with structurally polished, velvety tannins providing a satisfying finish.

Winemaker Notes:

Small in size, the Cabernet Sauvignon berry can produce wine of great complexity. Prolonged fermentation on skins and patient maturation for 24 months in French oak casks has produced this wine with solid fruit flavors, complimentary oak characters and a bold finish.

Food Pairing: Kangaroo medallions with plum sauce, roast meats, rich slow-cooked beef brisket, BBQ Ribs, peppercrusted Ahi Tuna
